Dear Praying Friends,

There are many things that I need to update you about in this letter, not the least of which is the recent salvation of one of our girls. Thirteen-year-old Jahryah, who came into the Home last year, woke Mrs. Bawn up a little after midnight a few days ago tearfully wanting to “welcome Jesus into her heart”. Praise God for when He makes the matter of salvation **urgent** in the hearts of sinners!

Secondly, please continue to pray for Melanie, as she will have scans on June 9th to verify that the cancer has not returned. I had mistakenly thought (and so written) that it would take place in May. I will update via email as soon as we have results from her scans. Over the past few weeks, Melanie and I have been blessed to visit supporting Churches in Missouri, West Virginia, Pennsylvania, and in a few days will be in Kentucky. It has been a great blessing to have her with me on these trips, especially since she will not be travelling with me to Thailand at this time. I had hoped that she might be able to come this fall, but it seems very unlikely that will happen. The requirements for entering Thailand, and associated expenses, are through the roof. The Covid situation seems to be worsening in many Asian countries. In Thailand, April and May have been by far the worst months thus far. Schools are closed and much of the ministry we were doing in villages has been paused. As far as I know, they are **not** considering another complete shut-down of the country. Please pray they do not.

Thankfully, I was able to get my Visa about two weeks ago, and have since acquired the “Certificate of Entry” which is another new requirement. Only a couple of small requirements remain to be met. Lord willing, I will fly out on June 25. When I reach Bangkok, I will have to quarantine there for 2 weeks (15 nights), and then, when I move on to Chiang Rai, I will have to self-quarantine for another 7 days. It will be such a “burden lifted” to finally get back, and already has been very encouraging just to get through the seemingly endless Visa process. But there are still many uncertainties because of the situation in that part of the world. I will transit through Japan, which is also being hit hard right now. Please continue to pray that God will soon get us there – IN HIS WILL. Hopefully, the next newsletter will be written from there.

Thank you for continuing to help and pray for our staff and our children there – who are all doing well, by the way. Praise be to our Gracious Lord!!!
